

1. Take two of your hoodie chews, your replacement hoodie string and the piece of ribbon which arrived in your pack



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2. Tie the replacement hoodie string to the existing string as shown



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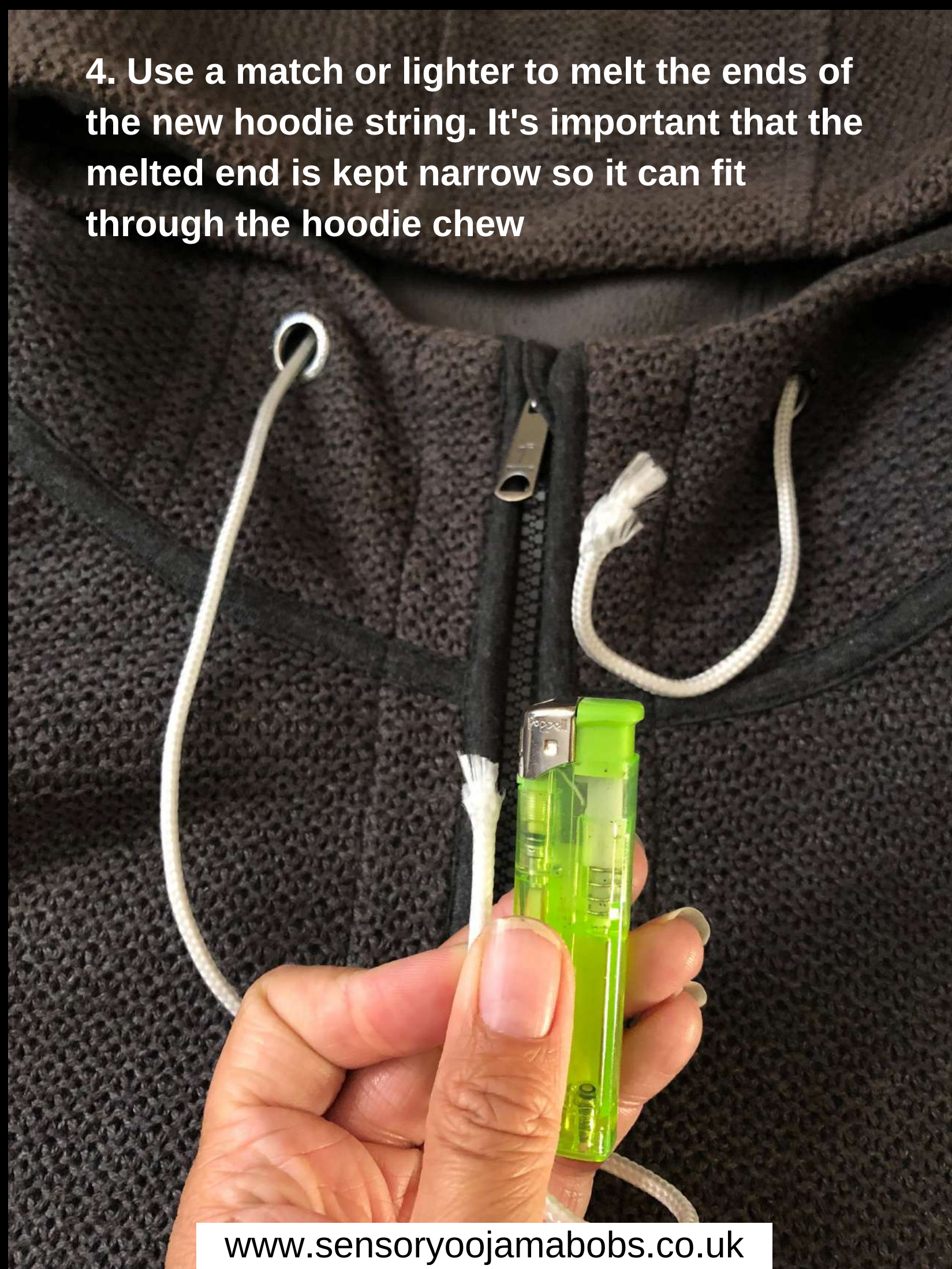
3. Using the other end of the existing hoodie string, pull the new string through the hoodie. Once the new string is in place, untie your knots

Tip: It can be helpful to push the knotted parts through the first eyelet to make it easier to pull through



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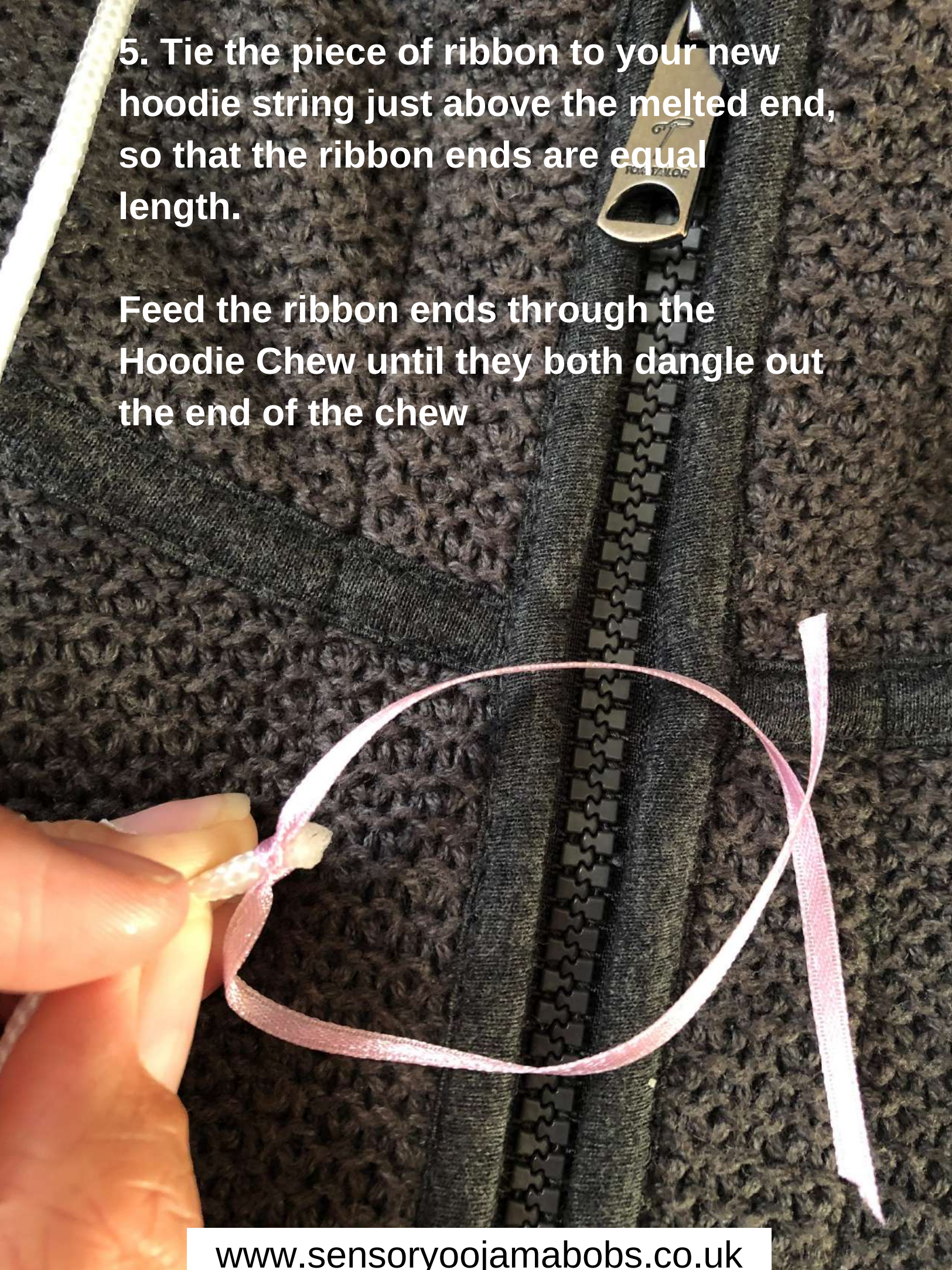
4. Use a match or lighter to melt the ends of the new hoodie string. It's important that the melted end is kept narrow so it can fit through the hoodie chew



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5. Tie the piece of ribbon to your new hoodie string just above the melted end, so that the ribbon ends are equal length.

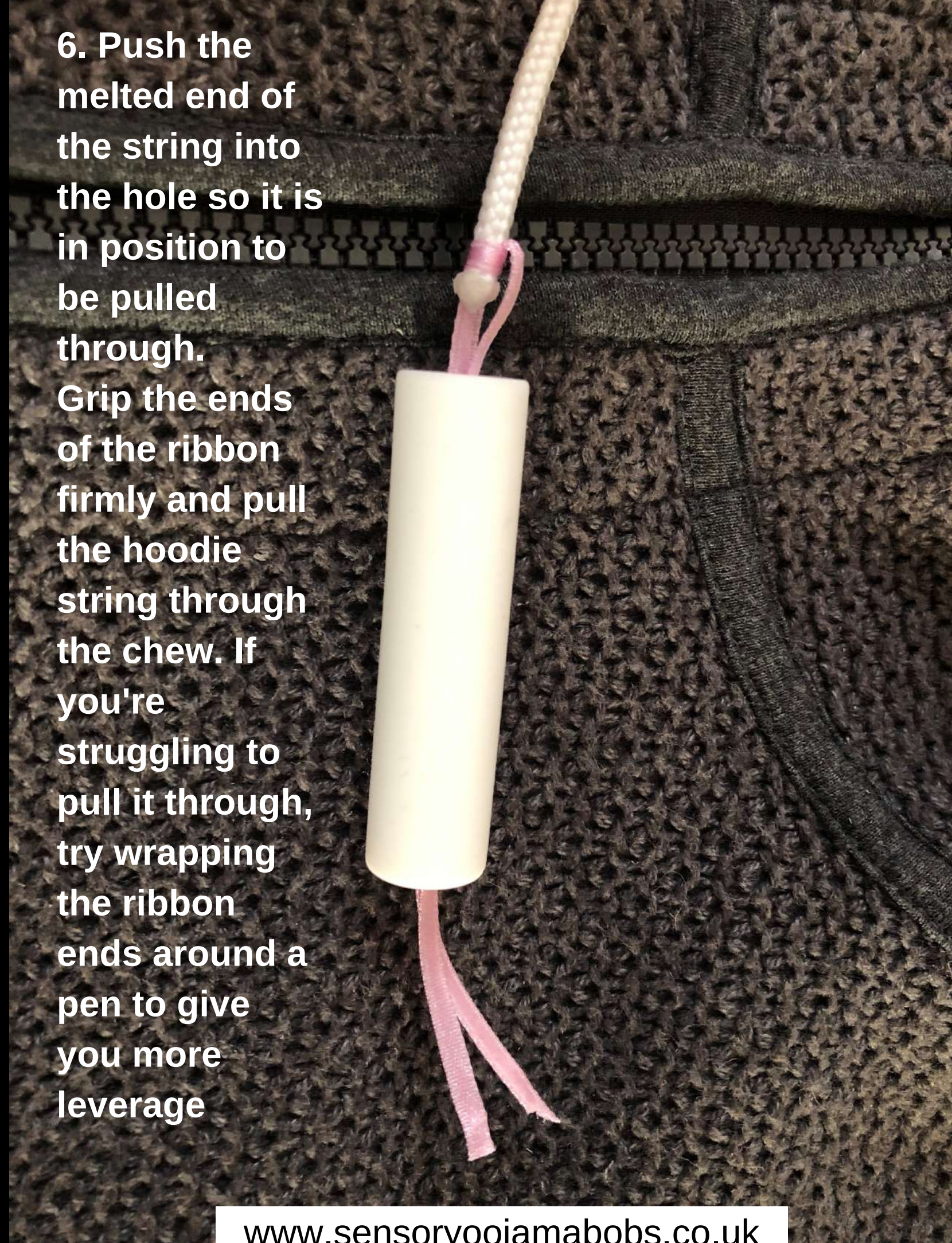
Feed the ribbon ends through the Hoodie Chew until they both dangle out the end of the chew



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6. Push the melted end of the string into the hole so it is in position to be pulled through.

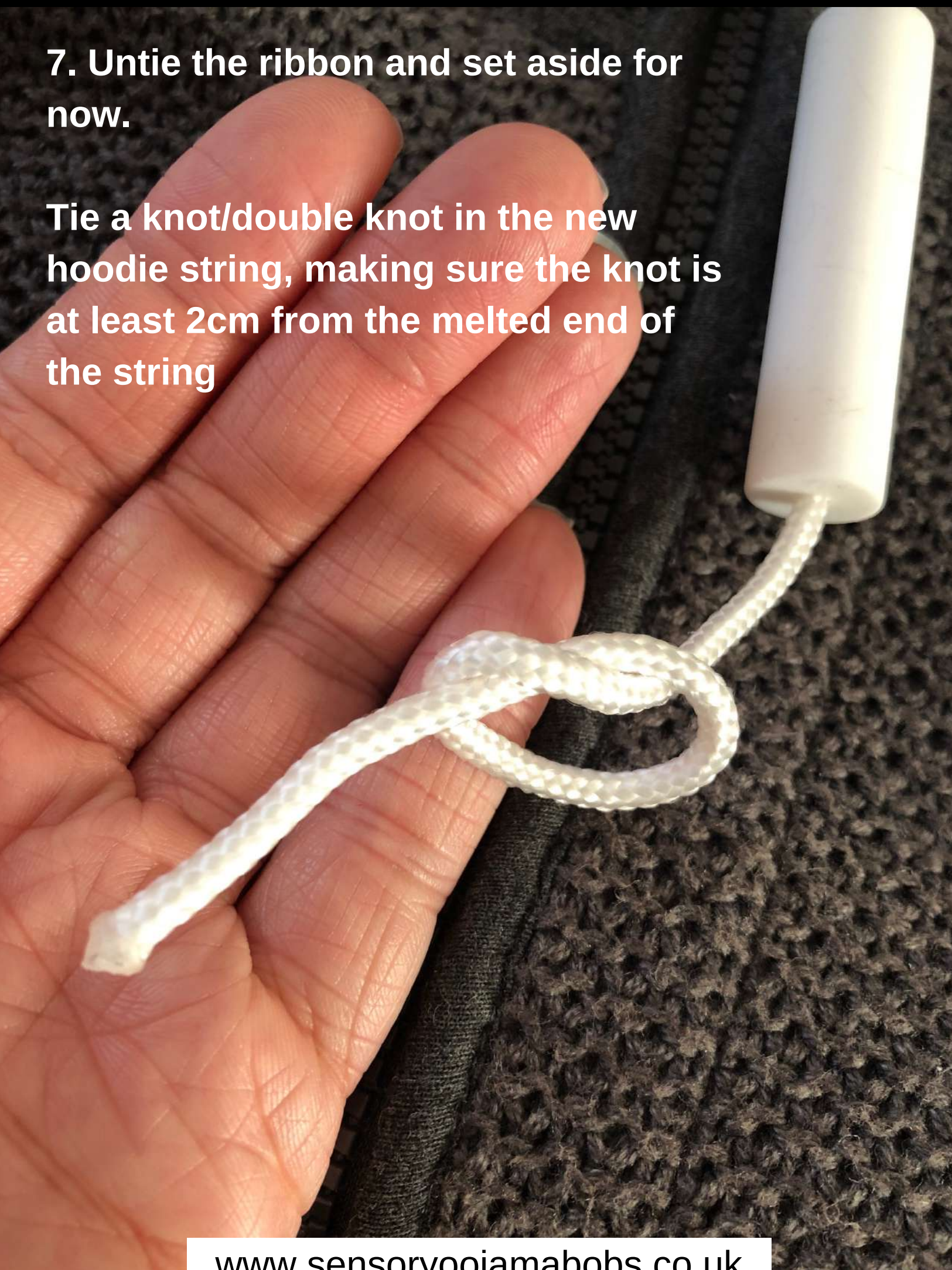
Grip the ends of the ribbon firmly and pull the hoodie string through the chew. If you're struggling to pull it through, try wrapping the ribbon ends around a pen to give you more leverage



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7. Untie the ribbon and set aside for now.

Tie a knot/double knot in the new hoodie string, making sure the knot is at least 2cm from the melted end of the string



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Repeat steps 1-7 on the other side



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
